

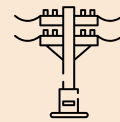
Is Your Community Broadband-Ready?

Utah communities across the state are preparing for high-speed internet deployment. Is your community ready? Use this checklist to prepare for broadband deployment projects in your area.



Infrastructure Readiness

- Assess infrastructure needs, including utility pole replacements
- Address maintenance and upgrade requirements
- Establish railroad or canal company right-of-way contacts and requirements



Utilities

- Clarify whether your community is under a cooperative system or power company partnership



Environmental Reviews

- Identify compliance representatives
- As needed, contact entities like the U.S. Forest Service, Bureau of Land Management, or Tribal lands



Permitting Processes

- Streamline the permitting process
- Waive or decrease permit costs
- Understand the possibilities of right-of-way obstacles or delays
- Work with entities to establish timely processes for projects
